EDP University of Puerto Rico, Inc., founded in 1969, began as a post-secondary education institution to respond to the rising demand for skilled workers in the data processing field. Its founders, Engineer Aníbal Nieves and Gladys Vázquez, developed the first technical course to train professionals who could manage the first phase of mechanization of the government and create computer programs that would address local needs.

In its 56-year history, EDP has expanded to six academic units that are strategically located throughout Puerto Rico: Hato Rey, San Sebastián, Manatí, Humacao, Villalba, and Caguas, and include distance learning programs.








